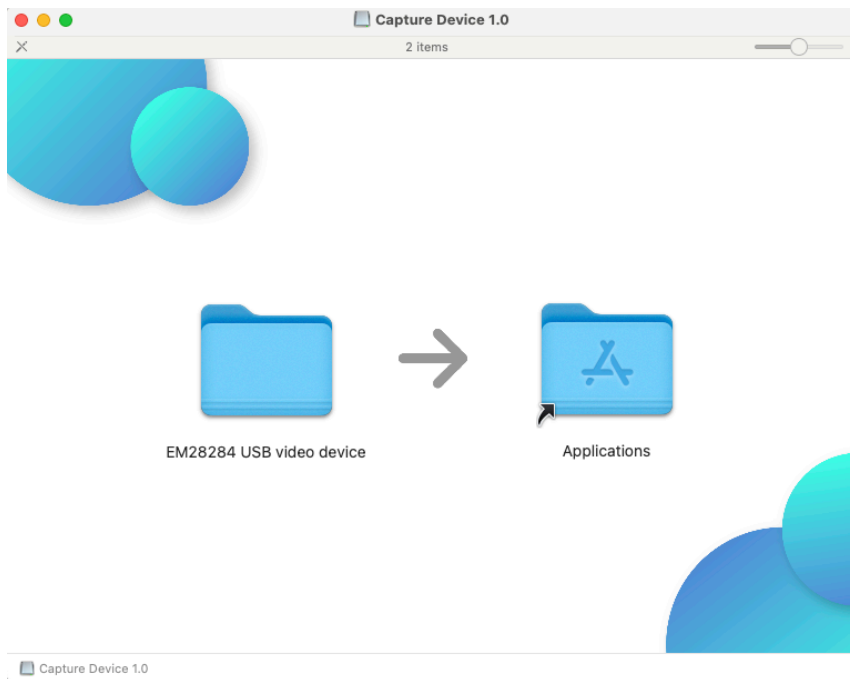
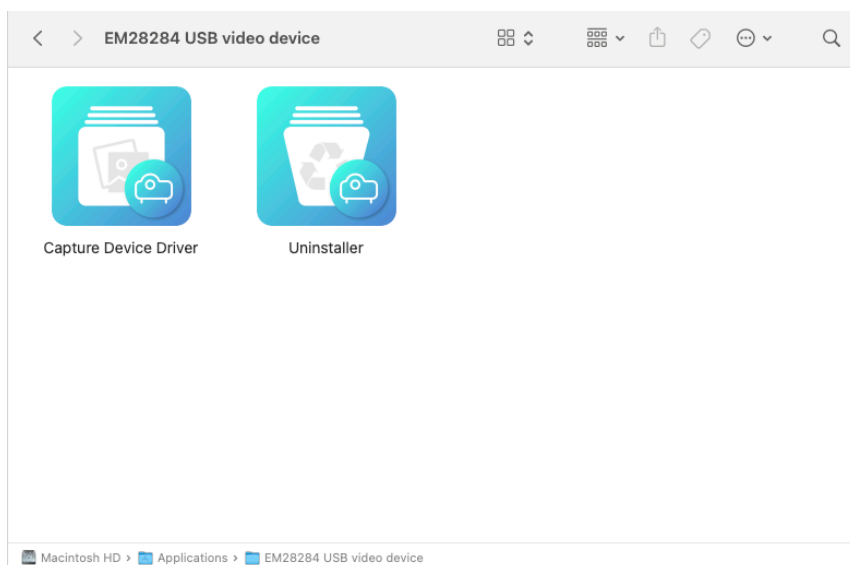


Double click **Capture Device 1.0 dmg** file and drag the folder into Applications shortcut as shown.



The folder contains an installer and an uninstaller

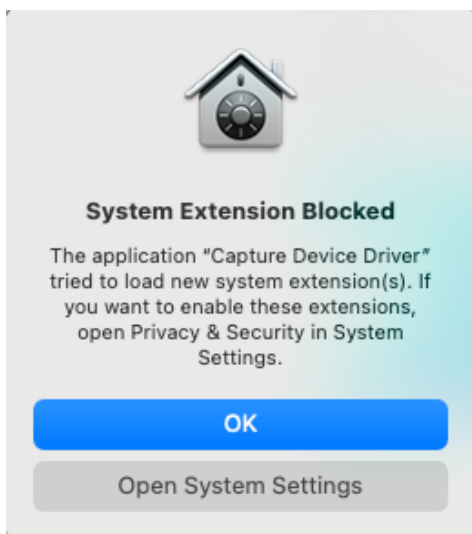


Double click **Capture Device Driver**

The new driver bundle is the combination of hardware USB Driver + upper layer Camera Extension, both requires user's explicit permission to be installed.

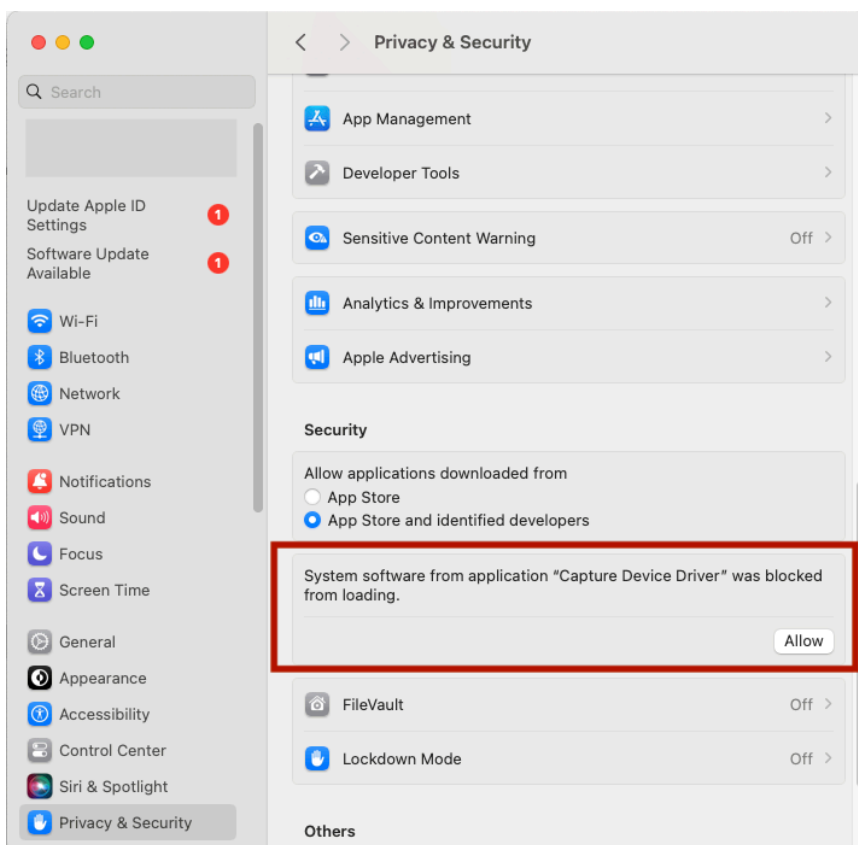


When user clicks install, a system message window will prompt



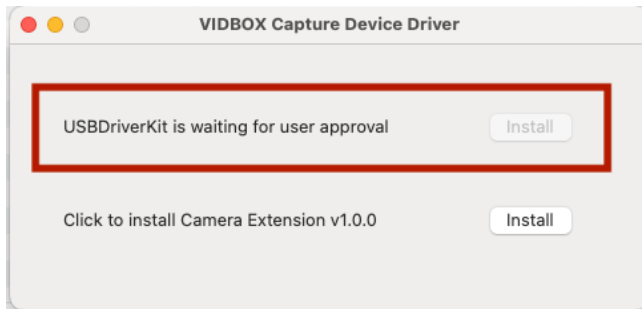
Clicking "**Open System Settings**" will bring up System Settings. This is where the user can grant the permission.

Note: Clicking "**OK**" does not install the driver, it is merely the indication of the user acknowledging this message.



Clicking "**Allow**" to and then enter your credential to install the driver

The message will display according to installation status.



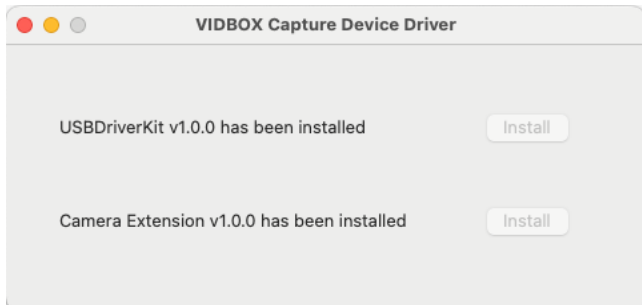
Message indicating it is still waiting for the above step to complete



Message indicating the driver installation is complete

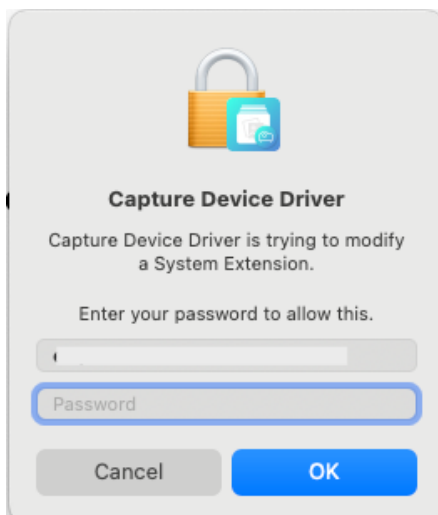
Repeat above steps for the other driver.

The order of which driver is installed first is not relevant.



The Capture Device Driver App can be closed once both drivers are installed.

For uninstallation, run the Uninstaller and follow the prompt.



The user will see this twice because there are two different drivers, and Apple requires explicit consent when modifying each driver

Click **“Yes”** to delete the folder and files, or click **“No”** to keep those
